Getting to Division of Industrial Ecology (May 18)

Address of the Industrial Ecology Division is Teknikringen 34 (building K).

You need to walk directly forward from the subway (letter T on the map) up passing road crossing, then passing by the newly constructed Architecture Department Building and the KTH Library on the left after.

We meet near the entrance of the IE Division building on Monday at 9:40 and then we go together to the Brinellvägen 8, where we have first meeting on Monday.

Transportation

From the airport

We expect all of you arrive to Stockholm Arlanda airport (if not, let us know). There are several simple options to get from it to Stockholm.

Arlanda Express

It's quite expensive (260 SEK, but there are significant discounts if taking group ticket for 2-4 people), but is for sure the fastest and the most reliable way of commuting between the airport and the city.

You can take it either from Terminal 5, or Terminals 2-4.

Taxi

Makes big sense when travelling in a group. Use taxis with fixed price (it should be ~ 500 SEK). We recommend Taxi o2o, Taxi Kurir, Taxi Stockholm companies.

Local transportation

Stockholm has very efficient local transportation system (SL), you can schedule your journeys and find maps at their website <http://sl.se>. We recommend to buy week ticket on the very arrival - that will provide you full freedom to go anywhere. Tickets can be bought in any Press Byron (small shops), SL Centers at the Central Station/Tekniska hogskolan, SL automatic machines at any subway station.

Weather

Weather forecasts are not very stable for Stockholm – in average it would be up to +12+14 during the day. Morning and evenings can be cool, so it's best to pack a light jacket and sweater. Also it can be rainy during the day, be sure to take an umbrella or light rain jacket.

Money

Local currency is Swedish krona (SEK), 1 SEK = ~ 0.11 EUR. Credit cards are accepted everywhere, there are quite exchange points in the city and most of them would be closed on Sunday, so if you need to exchange money do it in the airport – the exchange rates there are regular.
